Meeting called to order at 9:AM by Supervisor Englerth.

Present: Lippert, Campbell, Rottschaffer, Englerth. Absent with notice: Jerkatis.

Purpose of the meeting: Review Contract offer from Charter Communications to have available cable internet connection at the Fire Barn.

Clerk made inquire at Charter. Explained that at the time the fire barn was built, availability to make the connection would have been costly.

Customer service representative David Johnston contacted Jan Lippert with costs to install. 268 feet underground to the electrical meter would be \$2314.00 plus a standard installation of the cable of \$99.

Mr. Johnston made offer to waive the construction costs and installation if the Township signed an agreement (contract) by November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

Upon John Jerkatis' request, Jan looked into Hughes Net Company for a price. Hughes offer of internet only was \$98. Per month. They have no telephone service.

Discussion: Would be good to have internet available at the Fire Barn. Wi-fi available for cell phones tablets, etc. for the Fire Dept., Marine Patrol.

Currently AT&T is the phone service at the Station, that too would be changed to Charter (is less costly compared to monthly charge at AT&T of \$64. Per month)

Clerk clarified the construction would take place in Spring of 2015.

Motion by Englerth; supported by Lippert to authorize Clerk to sign contract with Charter Business internet & phone service beginning Spring of 2015.


